

- Register at EcoVadis
- Carry out the assessment (yearly basis)

#### Certificates

Obtain an ISO 14001 Certificate



- ISO 50001
- ISO 45001

#### **Motherson CoC**

- Commit to our Supplier Code of Conduct, including Policies on e.g. Ethics / Compliance
- Use our whistleblower system to report violations

### 3. Requirements - In Serial Production



- Maintenance of ecovadis assessment (Scorecard) and **CMRT** on a yearly basis.
- Collaborate on Sustainability Audits of your facilities, to ensure compliance with ESG standards and review your progress.



- Continuously report the % of Renewable Energy for your plants to reflect your progress (provide electricity evidences/certificates, e.g. EAC or PPA).
- By 2040, only Renewable Energy should be used in our products.



- In case of **Human Rights Violations** in your supply chain, contact your MPP Procurement representative
- Commit to the **Action Plans** provided via EcoVadis.



- Communicate your CO<sub>2</sub> Improvement Plan (Scope 1,2 & 3) in line with our defined milestones.
- Provide PCF data (e.g. via IMDS).
- Share your Waste Reduction Plan.




